Duke of Edinburgh; Bronze/Silver


- Consists of an expedition, skill development and voluntary work.

Dance Leadership Level 2 – 1 hour

- Candidates should lead a minimum of ten hours of dance activity of which they have been the sole planner and organiser.

- 7. Pathways in dance






Wellbeing; Physical Activity – 1 hour
