Prizegiving

PSFA currently pays for approx. 500 prizes pa at £5 per head. Suggested increasing amount to £10 but this would entail PSFA doubling the amount it contributed, so would need to raise more funds. Petra to find out if Waterstones can do £7?

Suggested many pupils prefer to read on a Kindle, rather than a book. However, books are more permanent, traditional and enable a physical prize to be awarded at the Prizegiving ceremony.
