### Dear Year 7 Parent

We hope that your child(ren) has/have settled into The Ecclesbourne School.

We would like to take this opportunity to tell you a little about the Ecclesbourne School Parent School & Friends Association (PSFA); how it helps the School and all pupils; and how you can get involved.

Over the last 10 years, the Ecclesbourne PSFA has donated more than £80,000 to the School - funding much-valued 'extras' - such as a laser cutter for the Technology Department; mental health workshops across all years; School atlases; whiteboards for the maths department; photography competition prizes; sports kits; and Prize Day awards.

In normal times, fundraising events take place throughout the school year and include support at Parents' Evenings (see below); provision of a bar at School productions; Nearly New Uniform sales; and our legendary Quiz & Chips evenings. Due to covid, many of our fundraising activities have been curtailed for 18 months, but we are now starting to resurrect them and would love to see some of our new parents getting involved.

Firstly, you will be experiencing your first Parents' Evening on 4 or 17 November. **At any in-School Parents' Evening, the PSFA runs a 50:50 raffle.** You will find members of the PSFA welcoming you to Parents Evening. They will be able to point you in the right direction to meet teachers and will also be asking you to buy a £1 Raffle ticket to help the PSFA (obviously if you wish to buy more than one ticket, that would be great and tickets are £1 each). All tickets are entered into a draw and whomever holds the winning ticket (which is notified through School), receives 50% of any money taken on the night from the sale of the raffle tickets, with the other 50% going into PSFA funds for school projects and activities. Our highest prize to parents so far was in excess of £100, so please, DON'T FORGET YOUR £1!!

We are also holding a **Big Christmas Raffle** to increase PSFA funds – and you will be sent a separate communication about this. Please consider supporting us by buying a £3 raffle ticket and you will also be in the draw to win over £5,000 in prizes.

On an ongoing basis, we ask all parents to sign up to EasyFundraising.
