Final Arrangements for Year 13

We are all very much looking forward to celebrating Year 13 students time with us during the morning and evening on Friday 12 May. There will be a special assembly and refreshments in the morning and of course the Sixth Form Ball at Derbyshire Cricket Club. Students will be welcomed at school from 4.30pm for friendship group photos and all students will need to be here by 6pm for the whole Year group photo. Buses will leave to take them to the County Cricket Club at 7pm. It is always such a special day, and we are sure your child will have a wonderful time.

I have included in a separate document the **study support and revision sessions that are available for students during examination leave**. When students attend school from the 15 May for these sessions they will need to sign in at Reception and sign out again when they leave. We will also have silent study available for Year 13 every day all day to support their revision from this date and throughout the examination period.

Following examinations, we require students to return laptops, cases and chargers along with any books or equipment lent to them by departments. Any debt on ParentPay accounts should be settled. **Students must complete a sign off sheet to confirm school property has been returned and debts cleared and return it to Sixth Form Office no later than 30 June.**

Results Day is Thursday 17 August. Sixth Form Office staff will be available to release results and provide advice and guidance for Year 13 from 8.00 am.

Examination certificates will be available for collection from the week commencing Monday 6th November. Students will be able to collect certificates from Reception provided their sign off sheet has been completed in full. If you would prefer to have certificates posted via special delivery, you can request and pay for this service using ParentPay. The cost is £6.35.
