Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Examination Certificates

I hope by now you have had chance to read through the 'Guide to Exam Season' leaflets with your child and that it has answered any questions you may have had. If you have more questions, do please get in touch.

Looking further down the road, post-results we will be sent examination certificates from the exam boards. Where they are GCSE certificates and students have remained in the Sixth Form, we distribute them directly to students. However, for Year 11 and Year 13 leavers we ask that students, or parents, come to collect the certificates from the school's reception. All certificates must be signed for. Certificates have usually arrived by the end of September, so we recommend that you come and collect them between 7th October – 25th October 2024.

Unfortunately, we are finding that many students don't come to collect their certificates and yet many years later they get in touch with us asking for them. We are only obliged to keep exam certificates for one year after they are issued. After that time, we can either send them back to the exam boards or we destroy them, as per the JCQ regulations. Given the expense of getting replacement certificates (upwards of £50 per certificate) we want to encourage our former students to come back to school to collect them.

If you would prefer for us to send the certificates then we can do this, however, we cannot cover costs because they would need to be sent by recorded delivery. If this is your preferred method, then you can pay for the cost of postage and packaging via ParentPay. The cost will be £3.60 per student. By doing this you are indicating to us that you would like us to send the certificates. Please can you do this **before the end of the academic year** (22nd July 2024). The address that we will send them to will be the one that we have on sims so please ensure that we have your current address on our system.
