Year 9 Options Process – Parents' Information Evening: 18th January 2024

Dear Parents and Carers,

May I take this opportunity to share with you some important information as we begin the GCSE option process. This process will be taking place during the Spring Term; key dates are given below.

Choosing GCSE options is an exciting time for students as they have the chance to decide the curriculum, they will follow for the next two years. The importance of the decisions being made means sometimes parents and students can feel a little worried, however, I would like to reassure you that the system of support and guidance we provide will help your child make choices that are right for them. Students will be able to ask their subject teachers about GCSE courses, they will have advice and guidance in their Personal Development and Citizenship lessons, and they will be allocated an experienced member of the Options Team to give them one to one support. All students have been working with their form tutor in their Wellbeing, Record of Achievement and Targets (WRATS) interview this week, looking at the assessment feedback from their interim report for this term.
