# TRIP510 Yr9 Residential trip to Outward Bound 2026 (Ogwen Cottage – Wales)

I am delighted to announce the proposed four-night residential adventure trip to the Ogwen Cottage Outward Bound centre, exclusively for our <u>current Year 8 students</u>. This trip will take place between **Monday 20th July 2026 and Friday 24<sup>th</sup> July 2026** and aims to provide students with the chance to develop team working, communication and analytical skills as well as self-confidence through real adventure.

The success of previous Outward Bound trips allows me to anticipate that demand for this trip will be high and places will be **limited to 36 students**.

The number of places available on this trip is limited and therefore places will be allocated to eligible students. Should the trip be oversubscribed, students will be given priority for a place in the following order:

1. Students who have been unsuccessful in gaining a place on a previous trip within the same school (Lower School/Senior Section/Upper School);

2. Students who have not previously been on a residential trip whilst in their current school (Lower School/Senior Section/Upper School);

3. All other students who have expressed a wish to partake in the trip.

The school carries some funds to help when families face severe financial difficulties.
