## Summer Uniform

Dear parents and carers,

As we move into the warmer weeks of the year, we will be relaxing our uniform regulations to help students stay cool and comfortable. From Thursday 19 June, our summer uniform regulations will come into effect and will remain in place until the end of term.

Tutors will explain these changes to students during registration, and they will continue to check that students are correctly dressed at both morning registration and after lunchtime, especially when returning from time spent on the field.

The updated summer uniform regulations are as follows:

- Ties are not required.
- Shirts and blouses must remain neatly tucked into skirts or trousers, except when students are on the field at lunchtime.
- Blazers and suit jackets (for Sixth Form) are not required.
- However, blazers or suit jackets remain the only permitted outerwear during the school day. Cardigans, sweaters, hoodies, or outdoor coats may not be worn in place of or without a blazer or suit jacket.
- There is no change to uniform requirements for trousers, skirts, or footwear.

While we recognise the need to adapt to the heat, we continue to expect the highest standards of dress and conduct from all our students. The relaxation of uniform rules is not an invitation to lower expectations; students are expected to take pride in their appearance and to maintain the positive attitude and work ethic we value so highly.

Please also encourage your child to stay well hydrated and to take care in the sun. We will continue to monitor weather conditions and make adjustments if necessary to support student wellbeing.
