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Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope that you had an enjoyable half term break. We are writing to inform you of a grant that is available for some of our families, and to respond to some of the feedback from our RSE Parent Survey.

## **Household Support Fund**

We have received information from Derbyshire County Council regarding the Household Support Fund (HSF 6). This is a grant awarded to local authorities by the Department for Work and Pensions to help vulnerable families and households facing financial difficulties in paying for food, energy and essential living costs.

Schools, in addition to other professionals working with families, can apply for this grant on your behalf. The funds are calculated at £65 for the first adult in the household, £15 for partner or spouse and for each dependent child under 19.

We will need to know your date of birth, national insurance number, and a brief reason as to why you would like us to apply for the funding. Ideally, we would need to see at least one form of evidence to prove financial hardship this could be a bank statement (a screen shot of an online banking app will be fine), details of upcoming direct debits/standing orders which need to be paid, benefit award statements, letters/bills etc. We will be asked to state what evidence we have reviewed on the application and assessment form, but we will not send this in with the application.
