Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Post Results Services

I hope that you and your child are enjoying the summer so far, with revision and exams now safely in the rear window! With the summer holidays on the horizon, results days draw ever closer, hence, it is opportune to take you through the post-results services which are available.

Please can I ask you to read through this information carefully *before* results day.

Should you child's results be lower than they expected there are a number of options available:

1. Access to Scripts. This requires written consent from the candidate (an email will suffice). It incurs no cost for an online copy of the script. This is processed by the Exams Office and scripts will be emailed to students. The deadline for this is **24th September 2026**.
2. Priority Review of Marking (A LEVEL / LEVEL 3 ONLY). This requires written consent from both the candidate and a parent/guardian (because the mark, and thus grade, could go down). This option is suitable for students who may have missed out on their post-18 placement. These reviews are returned within 15 calendar days. The deadline for this is **20th August 2026**.
3. Review of Marking. This requires written consent from both the candidate and a parent/guardian (because the mark, and thus grade, could go down). The review is returned within 20 calendar days. The deadline for this is **24th September 2026**.

Decision-making advice regarding post results services

- Talk to your child about how they think the examination went.
- Consider their response in line with the entry requirements of their next pathway.
- Please be aware that the papers are not re-marked, rather than the examiner's marking is reviewed. That means that the marking has to be in tolerance. For example, if Level 5 has a mark band of 10-12 and the original examiner awarded the response 10 and the reviewer awarded the response 12 then the mark wouldn't change because it is in tolerance of the mark band. For that reason, it can be helpful to get access to scripts in the first instance.
- If you decide to request one of the post-results services, follow the process below.

The process



To ensure that all requests are processed in a timely manner, it is important that the process above is followed. There are different forms for A level and for GCSE:

On receipt of the form, we will inform Finance of the costs of your requests, which will be added to your Parent Pay account. As the diagram shows, on payment we will process the request. You will be emailed the result of the review as soon as it comes to us.

The costs vary between exam boards and can be seen below. Please note that the costs are per paper/component, not per subject.
