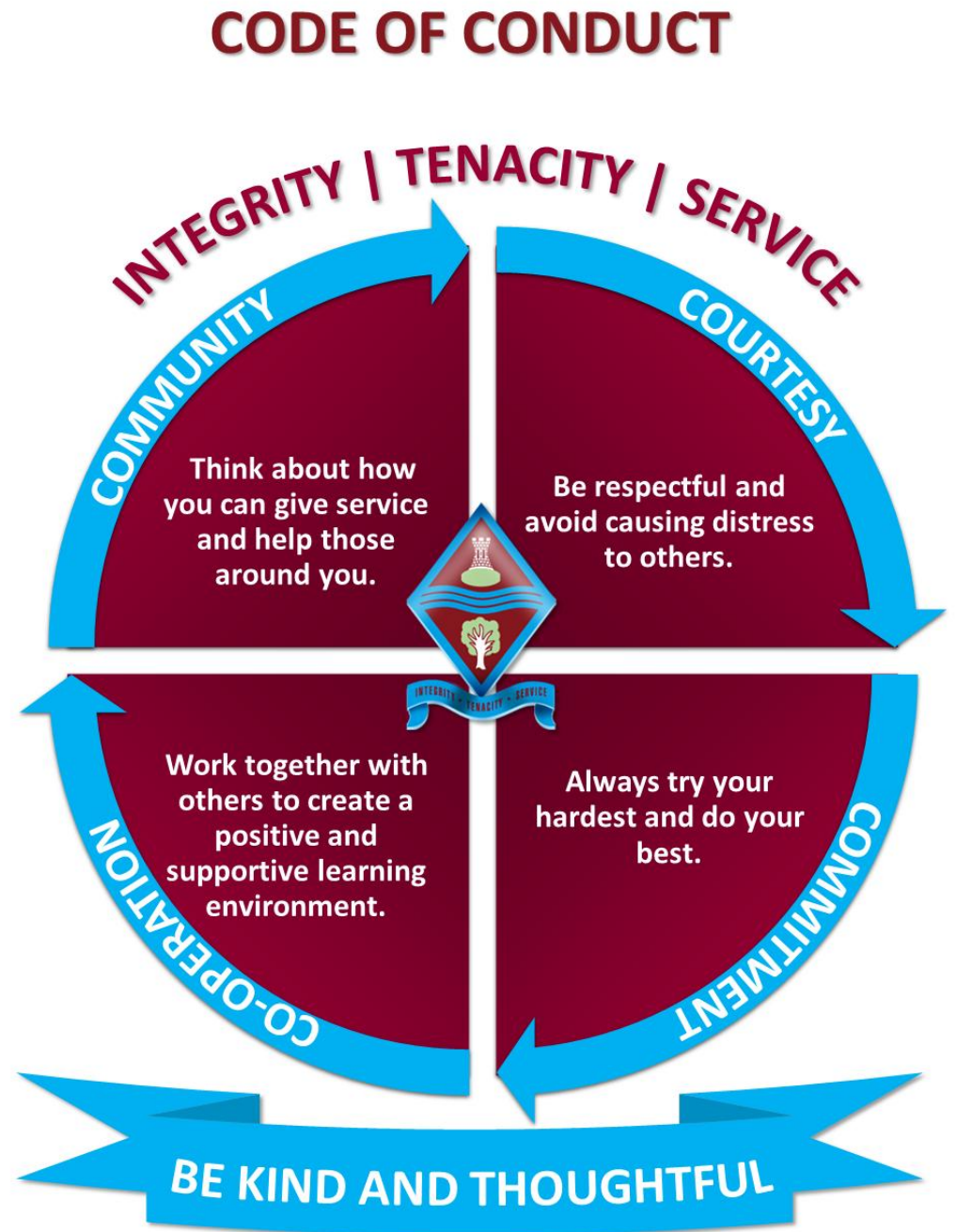

You CAN revise from your own notes.

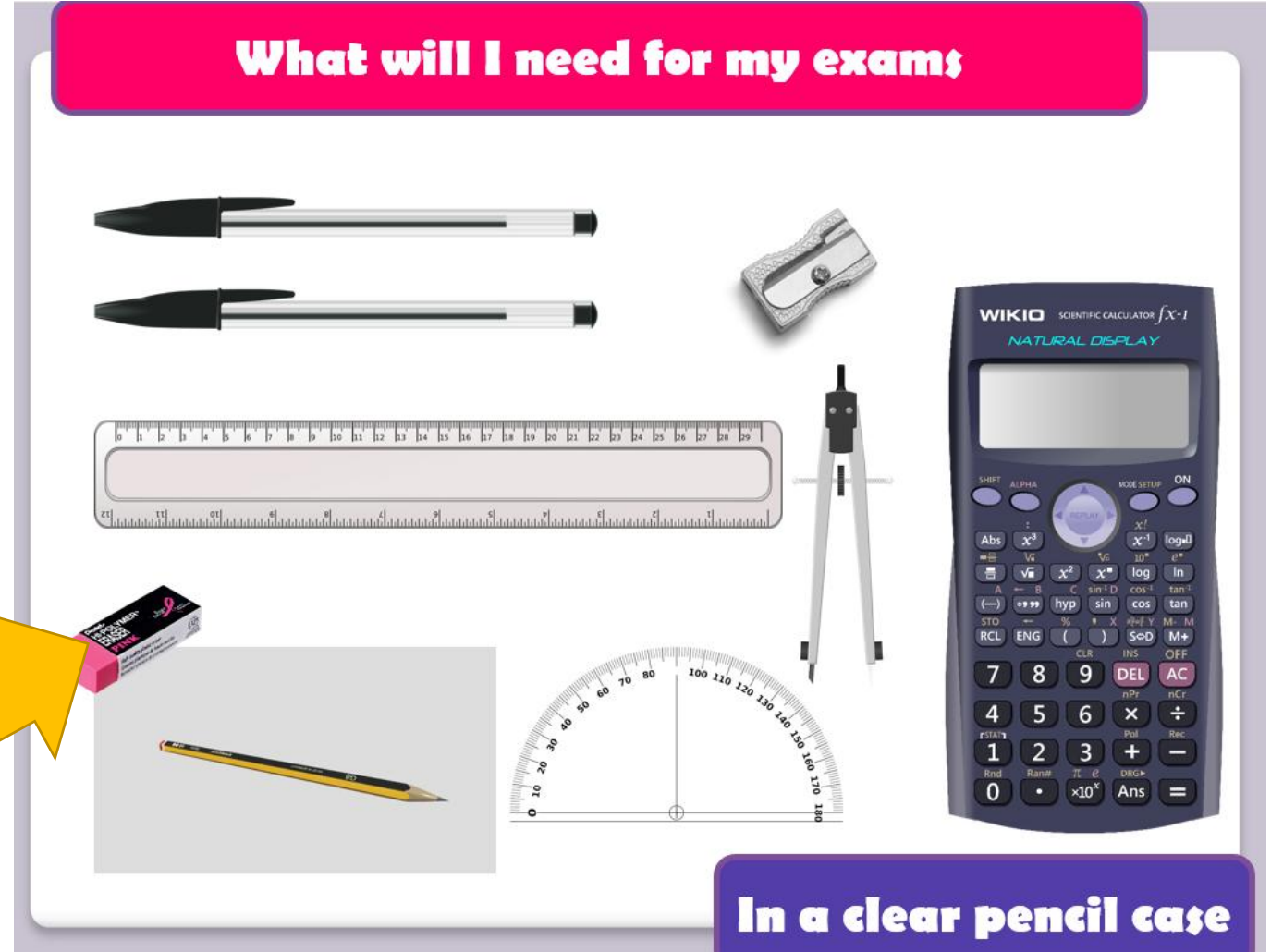
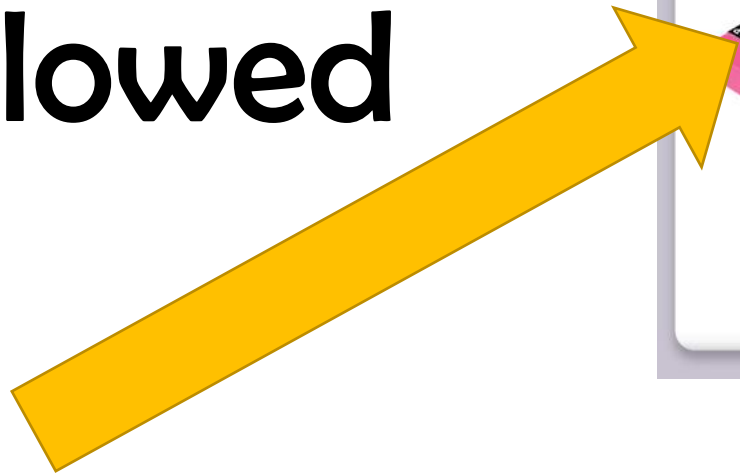

No phone, smart watch

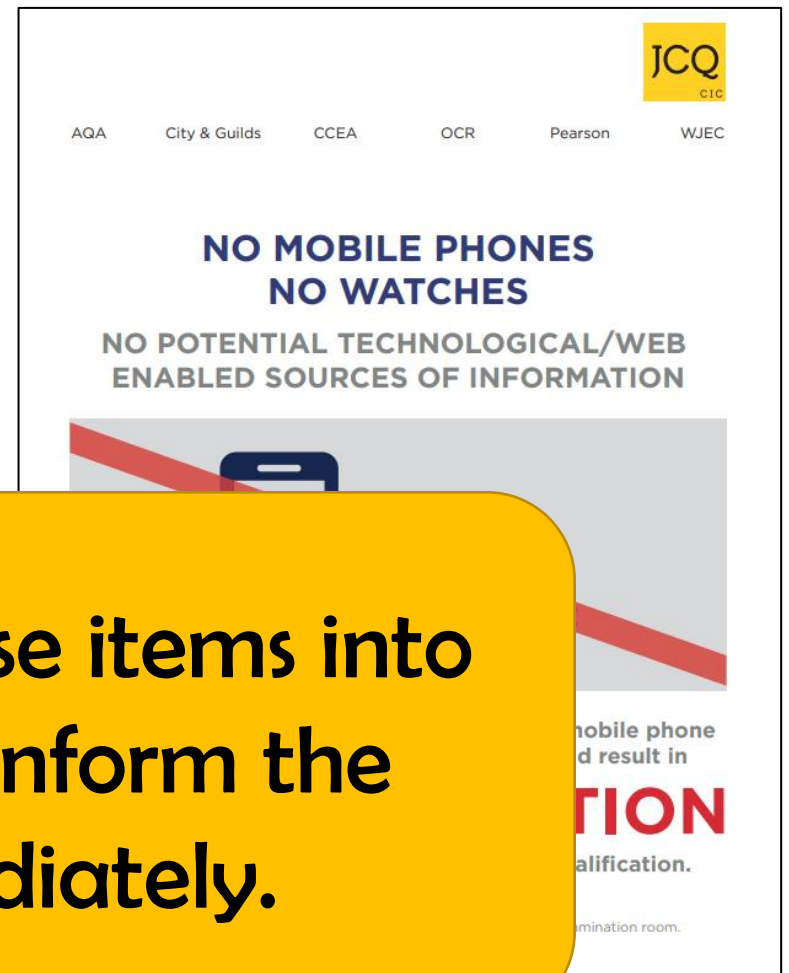
No watch (of any kind)

# Lanyards

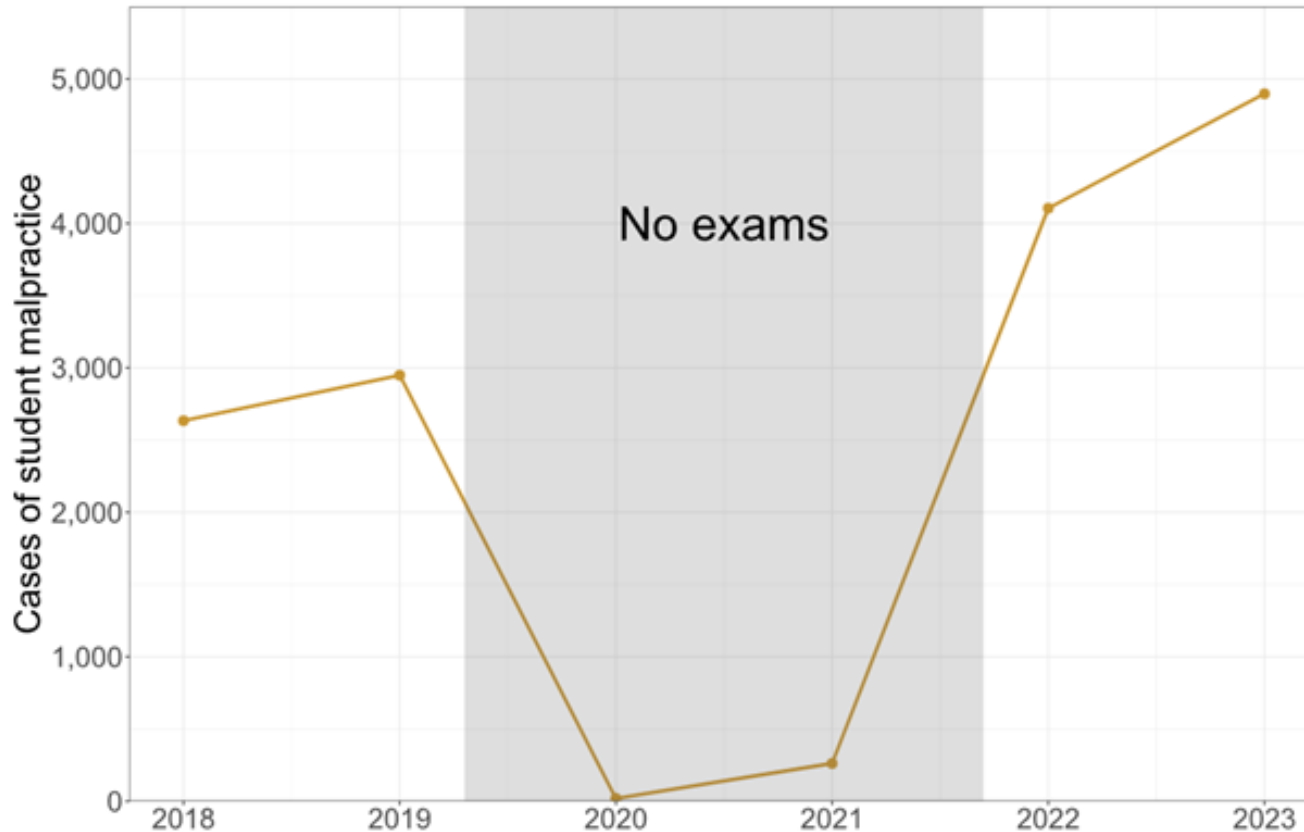
You **MUST** wear your lanyards.

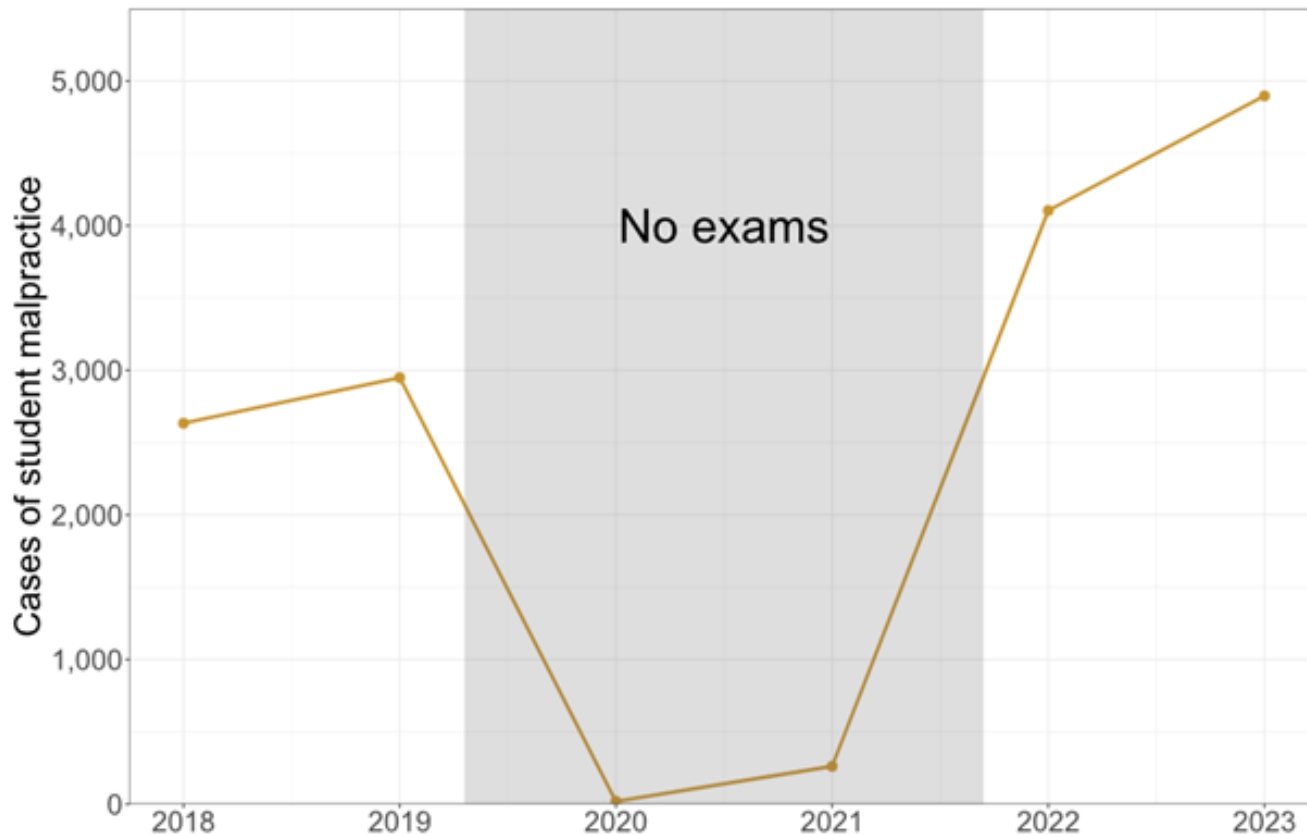

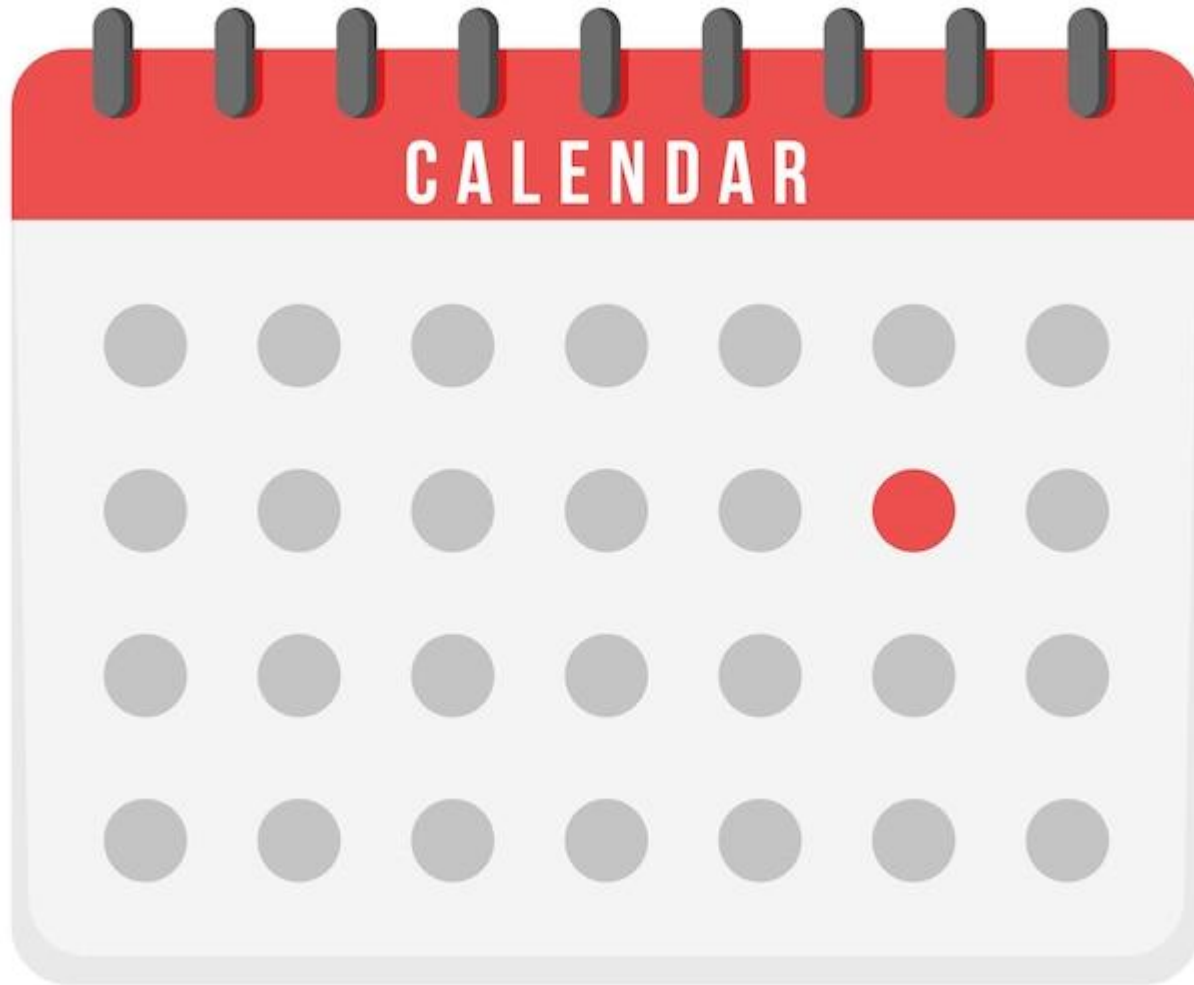
# Emergencies

A level & GCSE leavers– You can pay for us to send your certificates to you in the post (Parent Pay)


