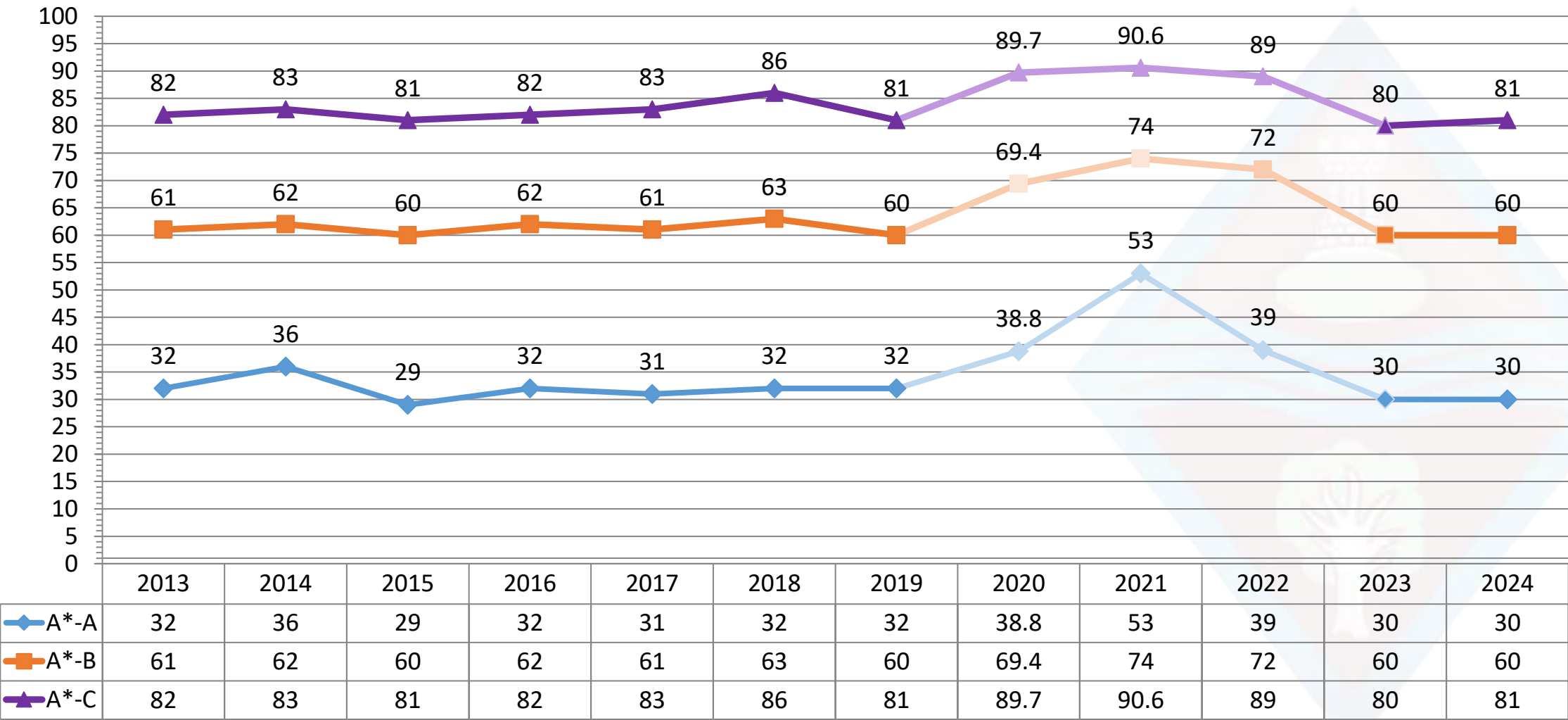

  - **March / April 2025** - conditional offers issued to all applicants who meet requirements
